Washington D.C., 27 October 2015

Report of Prof. Fabio Pigozzi, EOC Medical and Antidoping Commission

1. *Activities of the EOC Medical and Antidoping Commission*

The EOC Medical and Antidoping Commission continued its cooperation with the EOC Hdq. as well as with the Organizers of EOC Sport Events on the aspects related to the medical assistance, the first-aid services and the anti-doping in the following events in 2015:

- **EYOF 12th Winter Edition – 25-30 January 2015, Vorarlberg & Liechtenstein (AUT/LIE)**
- **EYOF 13th Summer Edition – 26 July -1 August 2015, Tbilisi (GEO)**
- **1st EUROPEAN GAMES – 12-28 June 2015, Baku 2015 (AZE)**

Medical assistance has been provided to 5.752 athletes representing 50 NOCs competing in 253 events across 20 sports in 16 competition venues. With respect to doping controls 1024 samples (919 urine incl. 214 EPO plus 105 blood) from 820 athletes in 3 phases have been carried out (pre-games; out-of-competition; in-competition). 3 AAF have been detected: the athlete who was found positive within pre-games testing was not allowed to travel to Baku. The other 2 AAF were detected in one out-of-competition and in one in-competition tests.

2. *IOC Medical and Scientific Commission meeting, Lausanne, Switzerland 14-16 October 2015*

The meeting was attended by the IOC Medical and Scientific Commission Chairman, Prof. Uğur Erdener. The reports have been focused on the 2016 Rio de Janeiro Olympic Games, Medical services, Public health, Needle & equipment policies and TUEs. Additional topics have been represented by the IOC Medical and Scientific Department activities and the IOC consensus statements on youth athletic development, on Relative Energy Deficiency in Sport and on Harassment & Abuse in Sport. Furthermore, most of the IFs Representatives reported on medical specific issues. In addition a session was focused on the water quality in Guanabara Bay, Marina de Gloria and Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas, with the participation of FINA, ITU, ISAF, ICF, FISA and the WHO. All the International Federation, except FISA, agreed that the water quality was appropriate, based on the outcomes of the relevant Test Events carried out in Rio de Janeiro.

3. *Annual Meeting 2015 - EOC "Medical and Antidoping" Commission*

The Annual Meeting 2015 of the EOC "Medical and Antidoping" Commission will be held in Prague on 19th November 2015.

4. WADA

As WADA Foundation Board member representing ANOC I participated to the WADA Foundation Board Meeting, held on 13 May 2015 in Montreal, Canada and I look forward to participate to the next Foundation Board Meeting, to be held in Colorado Springs, USA, on 18 November 2015.
